Newsprints	Canvas prints from newspaper that shows the link between local business, the community and school.	£120	Promoted PE in school as well as recognised the contribution of our children over the past few years. Constant reminder for current pupils of our success.
Greenacre school	The payment to join up with the Greenacre School Partnership who provide, resources, entry into competitions, support in lessons and training for both pupils and teachers.	£3000	Delivery of PE lessons has improved greatly as more support is being given. Playground leaders have been trained which has led to improved activities at Lunch and break times and resources available throughout school have improved. Continued participation in competition has led to children experiencing inter and intra school sport.
Greenacre School	Greenacre provided planning and assessment resources to aid teachers.	£600	Greenacre have provided plans and assessment girds to further aid teachers in class time to help children reach their potential.
PE Cover	Supply cover to attend competitions and courses.	£3600	Supply cover to allow children/teachers to go and compete in and out of school competition and also attend courses to aid development of staff skillset.
